In 2025, the magic of Christmas returns bigger than ever with exciting new features that enhance the visitor experience while staying true to the show's roots. Guests can explore a brand-new Vintage Section, where timeless finds spark nostalgia; immerse themselves in a European-style Christmas Market filled with festive décor, gifts, food, and drink; delight in an expanded Flavours section that highlights gourmet creations from across Canada; and discover the artistry and traditions of five extraordinary makers in a special Northwest Territories Pop-Up.

Beyond shopping, One Of A Kind presents a dynamic lineup of daily programming designed to inspire and entertain. On the Main Stage, fashion shows highlight artisan designs, joined by keynote speakers and influencer spotlights. The Creative Lounge invites guests to get hands-on with daily DIY workshops led by Studio Mooi, Noble Space, and the Haliburton School of Art & Design, while a collaborative colouring wall, created by a One Of A Kind artisan, encourages creativity for all ages. In the Flavours Demo Area, chefs and experts share expert tips for elevating holiday entertaining. New this year, the Maker Takeover series offers guests the chance to learn directly from artisans through main stage presentations, DIY sessions, and culinary demos.
