According to the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long Term Care, Infection Prevention and Control Best Practices for Personal Services, January 2009, accidental exposures to blood or body fluids to the client or operator must be documented. The PSS owner must keep these records on site for a minimum of one year, and on file for a minimum of five years.

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
